

VETERAN ADMISSION

The University of Miami welcomes applications from military/veterans and their dependents who are eligible for education benefits offered by the Department of Veterans Affairs, including the Post-9/11 GI Bill and the Yellow Ribbon Program.

If veterans have not earned any college credits after high school graduation, they should apply as a first-year student. Refer to the First-Year Admission Requirements section for additional details. If veterans have taken degree-seeking college credits after high school graduation – regardless of the number of credits earned – they should apply via the transfer process. Transfer applicants should refer to the Transfer Admission section for additional details.

Military/veteran dependents who are graduating from high school must apply as a first-year student.

The University of Miami will award up to six elective credits with the submission of the DD 214 form, which shows veterans were honorably discharged.

The Common Application fee is waived for active military/veterans and their dependents. The \$500 nonrefundable enrollment deposit fee will also be waived for active military members and veterans.
