Any student wishing to declare a Performance Certificate must audition on an instrument or voice and be approved by the appropriate department.

Coursework for the Performance Certificate is in addition to that of the primary degree plan, except as follows:

· Credits earned in performance ensembles may be used simultaneously toward completion of both the primary degree and the certificate.

The Music Performance Certificate will be awarded upon successful completion of all coursework and final approval of the designated departmental faculty. The appropriate performance level must be achieved as determined by the designated departmental faculty or the certificate will not have been earned, even if all courses have been successfully completed.

Students who will enroll in a required internship (i.e. student teaching) in their 8th semester may petition the department to perform the senior recital and satisfy the Principal Instrument Lesson & Studio Class degree requirements in their 7th semester.
