<sup>1</sup> Advanced level courses from other departments may be taken if approved by the INS advisor. Only courses in which a grade of C- or better is attained may be counted towards the minor in International Studies, and students must maintain a GPA of 2.75 or better in all minor requirements (15 credit hours).
