¹ All courses must be completed within the current pre-requisite structure. No one course may be applied toward more than one major and/or minor area of specialization in the Department of Management. (i.e., no double counting).

Note: All specific coursework for any minor in the Department of Management must be completed with a grade of "C" or higher. A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 is required for all specific coursework taken in the minor area of specialization.
